In 2013 and 2014 the Castle Rising History Group have attempted to do a survey of the memorials and gravestones in the Church and Churchyard of St Lawrence's Church as part of their research on the people who have lived in the village which was partly funded with a grant from the **Heritage Lottery Fund.** We are still hoping to clear more of the buried gravestones but below is the work to date.
